Do not use for: Property damage unless personal injury risk is present.



Use for: Hazardous situations that have some probability of death or severe injury.
Do not use for: Property damage unless personal injury risk is present.



Use for: Hazardous situations which may result in minor or moderate injury.
Do not use for: Situations when there is a possibility of death or severe injury.



Use for: Indicating a statement of company policy as the message relates directly or indirectly to the safety of personnel or protection of property.
Do not use for: Hazardous situations where death or severe injury may occur.



Use for: Indicating general instructions relative to safe work practices, reminders of proper safety procedures and the location of safety equipment.
Do not use for: Hazardous situations where death or severe injury may occur.
